Welcome to the second grade! This year is certain to be a memorable year of learning and growth. This booklet outlines the scope of our learning for this year and the sequence in which we will be addressing each subject. You will be able to use this guide to follow our path throughout the year.

Our school follows the California state standards and the Core Knowledge standards. Social Studies deals primarily with U.S. history with a section on Asia at the end of the year. Science touches on life science, earth science and physical science. Math takes a unit by unit approach beginning with addition and subtraction and progresses through three-digit numbers, multiplication, and division. In Spelling, the activities each month will be chosen from the concepts listed for that month. In some subjects such as Reading and Writing, similar concepts are taught each month.

The writing process taught includes prewriting, rough draft, revising, editing, publishing, and proof-reading.

Our Bible curriculum is from Concordia and takes us from Creation and the Old Testament to Jesus' life, death, and resurrection. It concludes with the early church and the evangelistic work of Peter and Paul.

In addition to our academic curriculum, students can look forward to many exciting opportunities. They will participate in weekly chapels. Weekly job responsibilities will enable each child to feel s/he is a productive member of the class. Each student will have his or her own buddy in the 5th grade. Special classroom theme days will occur periodically throughout the year.
